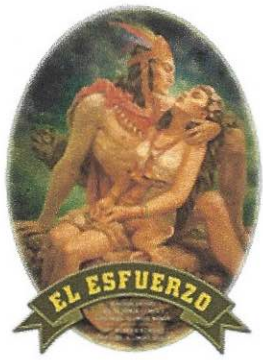

\$4,000

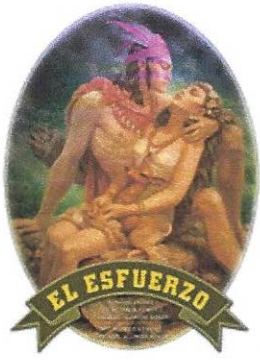
